

## Sketchbook 8th Grade- Altered Book Cover

### Learning Objectives

- Describes the life and work of Dan Eldon.
- Identifies the Characteristics of art form “altered books.”
- List specific techniques** used to alter books.
- Students will describe their own artistic vision.

### Process Objectives

- Students will **create** a mixed media **collage**.
- Students will design a composition that has a **main subject** or **focal point**.
- Students will draw **unique designs and ideas** to include in their collage.
- Students will use a **Minimum of 3** of the mixed media techniques learned in class.

### Criteria for Project

- 90% of the cover is used for images.
- Each pasted image is altered/modified (color added, drawn into, and/or transferred)
- Communicates a clear message/artistic vision.
- The image is well composed (subjects aren't smack in the middle, rule of thirds, etc...)
- The image is well crafted (the material presented appears to be intentional, as opposed to haphazard, sloppy, or rushed).
- The image includes **minimum of 3 images** drawn and/or painted by hand.
